## INFORMATION GOVERNANCE BODY OF KNOWLEDGE (IGBOK) OVERVIEW

ARMA International released the full version of the IGBOK late 2018. Sixteen subject matter experts were brought together with ARMA staff to create the IGBOK to guide organizations on how to address and manage Information Governance. Mr. Ysasi was one of the 16 writers who focused on the privacy section of the IGBOK and can help others understand all aspects of the IGBOK.

Andrew Ysasi, MS, FIP, FIIM, CIPM, CIPP, CISM, PMP, CRM, IGP, CIP has worked in information management since 2007 and is an expert on information governance and records management.
